





Left to right shaft conversion is an easy operation that takes minutes to be accomplished. Turning the manifold and the back cover up-side down are the two operations required to change crankshaft side.

- 1. Remove the eight manifold bolt n. 1 and separate the head from the pump. Turn the power end up side down and fit the manifold back in place, tightening the 8 bolts n.1 with a torque wrench set for 80** Nm. 2. Put the pump vertical, manifold facing, down in order to work on the back cover without having to drain the pump oil. Remove the back
- cover bolts n. 2, turn the back cover up side down and fit it back in place.
- ** The head screws, position 2, must be fastened respecting the phases indicated below
